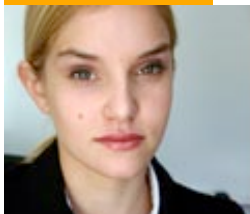

We are often asked, "Why are you trying to change the Internet?" The answer is, of course, because it needs to change.

Consider if you television worked the same as the Internet. From the moment you turned it on, you received every channel that is available including all the pornography channels.

How would you manage your children's access to television? Parental controls, V-Chip, pass codes, etc. can work, but the porn is already in the home and accessible.

What happens when your child learns how to disable those parental controls—or purchases his own TV. How do you stop it then?

The Internet needs the same kind of control and tools that are available for controlling television programming, tools that allow individuals and parents to choose what content enters their homes

UK Announces New Anti-Porn Law

Similar to Child Pornography laws, by specifically targeting violent forms of pornography, this new law will be vastly easier to prosecute, because it is not a question of whether it is pornography or offensive—but simply whether an element of sexualized violence is evident.
